Sumware is a freelance layout not based on any particular location, hence the name! The layout depicts a double track main line passing through two stations, which leads to hidden sidings. The main four platform station is named “Sumware”, which has the station buildings located on an overbridge from the adjacent town. This station also boasts a goods yard. The second station is named “Sumware East” and has two mainline platforms and also forms the terminus for the single-track branch line.
